

THE DOLOMITES



The Dolomites, immersed in a tropical sea, emerged only 70 million years ago. Worked and sculpted by atmospheric agents, today they represent a magnificent geological treasure and give the landscape an incomparable beauty. The particular type of predominant rock, the dolomite, gives the mountains a particular light hue, so the Dolomites also take the name "Pale Mountains". At dawn and dusk, the dolomite assumes a color from pink to red fire: the phenomenon is called Enrosadira and is particularly visible in summer evenings. The Ampezzo Valley is the ideal place to enter and discover a unique world made of vertical walls, green valleys, mountain pastures, forests, streams, lakes, canyons and waterfalls.



CORTINA D'AMPEZZO

Cortina d'Ampezzo holds the prestigious title of Queen of the Dolomites, Located at 1210 m altitude between the most known dolomitic summits: the Croda da Lago, the Nuvolau, the Five Towers, the Tofane group, the Cristal, the Faloria and the Sorapiss, which surround it majestically. It is characterized by a combination of art, history and nature that makes it unique and of great interest. The city, whose main center is the famous Corso Italia, is animated by restaurants, hotels, shops, commercial activities, including the historic Cooperative, which make Cortina the mountain resort par excellence. Cortina d'Ampezzo also has a rich natural and scenic heritage of rare beauty such as the Dolomites of Ampezzo Natural Park comprising the group of Tofane and Mount Cristallo extending to the Park of Fanes - Sennes -Braies. The whole territory of the Ampezzano lends itself perfectly to hiking and mountaineering.





LUNCH ON THE PROSECCO STREET



During the transfer, we will take a detour along the Prosecco Route, where, in addition to the ancient and beautiful villages of hills, we can taste the typical local product, famous throughout the world: the Prosecco sparkling wine.

Lunch with local produce and prosecco in one of the famous restaurants of the valley.



EXCURSION TO THE LAKE OF MISURINA

Lake Misurina, also known as "Perla delle Dolomiti" for its beauty, is the largest natural basin of the Cadore.

As a jewel set between the UNESCO Dolomites, Lake Misurina rises to 1756 m s.l.m. and is known, in addition to its charm, also for the therapeutic properties it offers thanks to its particularly healthy microclimate. Around Lake Misurina there are some of the most beautiful peaks of the Dolomites: the Tres Cimas de Lavaredo, the Sorapiss, the Cadini and the Cristallo.

It is the ideal place to undertake pleasant excursions in contact with nature, suitable for both families and expert hikers, but also to spend pleasant moments of relaxation.







HIGH MOUNTAIN EXCURSION



The Ampezzana basin, bathed by the sun, houses a wide selection of walks of any difficulty and duration for a total of 300 km of routes.

Among the most suggestive: the trail of Montanelli da Piè Tofana, in the Dolomiti d'Ampezzo nature park deserves the return of the Val Travenanzes and the waterfalls of Fanes for experts, excursions to the lake of Federa, the lakes of Pianozes, d'Ajal, Ghedina and Sorapiss, famous for the color of its waters.

Naturalistic or historical walks on the steps of the Great War that here has seen the mountains transform into galleries: an open-air museum between Cinque Torri, the Piccolo Lagazuoi and the Forte Tre Sassi.



EXCURSION TO LAGAZUOI

Passo Falzarego is a dolomitic pass at 2109 mt located between Lagazuoi and Col Gallina thanks to the Great Highway of the Dolomites, one of the most panoramic streets in the world, which connects Bolzano with Cortina.

From the pass, thanks to the famous cable car you can reach the top of Mount Lagazuoi at 2746 mt, from where you have an impressive view of the pass and the surrounding dolomitic peaks.





CIMA TOFANA TOUR





Cima Tofana: the third highest peak in the Dolomites. The second trunk of the cable car Tofana – Arrow in the Sky allows to climb to the highest summit of Cortina d'Ampezzo: the Tofana di Mezzo (3244 m).

From the large terrace you can admire a fantastic 360° panorama over the Dolomites. The view from there is something unique and spectacular, which makes Cima Tofana an almost "spiritual" place. Cima Tofana is also an excellent starting finishing base for railways and climbing. During the summer a resting point is opened and several meetings are organized that offer the possibility of attending, from a privileged position, at sunrise and sunset of the sun on the dolomitic summits that dominate the ampezzana basin.

These extraordinary natural events at altitude are accompanied by music and buffet for mountain fans who want to live an unforgettable experience.
